

# **Library Institutional Membership**

### **Library Rules for Student**

- 1. Library Books Issue/Return time: 9.30 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. and 1.30 p.m. to 5.30 p.m from Monday to Saturday.
- 2. A Student shall be issued one book at a time for seven days which can be extended to another week provided a request for renewal is made before the expiry date.
- 3. Second book will be issued on I-card for one day only. Otherwise, a fine Rs.25/- per daywill be charged up to 3 days, thereafter for 15 days the library issue facility will be stop.
- 4. Reference Books or Periodicals shall not be issued to the students but be made available to them in the library.
- 5. Book CD available at the issuing counter.
- 6. Students who keep the books after the expiry date will be fined Rs.10/- per week.
- 7. If a Student loses or damages any library book, the student shall have to pay double the MRP or replace the book (New Edition), within 15 days otherwise fine Rs. 10/- per day will belevied.
- 8. Always maintain silence in the library. Whispering and loitering are not allowed in the library and reading room.
- 9. Mobile phones need to be switched off or kept in the silent mode before making the entry to the library.
- 10. Library cards are not transferable, in case of loss of a library card; a duplicate card will be issued only once within 15 days, against a charge of Rs. 100/- per card. There after no duplicate card shall be issued.
- 11. Keep your personal belongings such as bags, books etc. in the Baggage counter. verified the fine record in time.
- 12. Do not keep any valuables such as Cash, Mobile, ATM card etc.
- 13. Library or the college staffs are not responsible for the loss of any valuables.
- 14. Library material can be photocopied (Question paper, syllabus, Reference books, Journal, Periodicals, Case Studies) etc. on payment of charges.
- 15. Any(B&W) computer print is available on payment of charges.
- 16. Students are requested to pay fine in time and show the receipt to library staff and verified the fine record in time.

### **Hostel Facilities**



### **Fee Structure**

### As per fees Regulating Authority of Govt of Maharashtra

### **Attention**

- In addition to the fees mentioned, the fresh entrants will have to pay T.C. fee of Rs. 200/in case they are coming from a college affiliated to the Savitribai Phule Pune University
  or any University within Maharashtra and Rs. 300/- if they come from other
  Universities/Boards.
- 2. Every fresh entrant in the College has to pay Rs. 60/- for the medical examination he/she has to undergo as per the Pune University Rules.
- 3. All fees are subject to change as per the FRA rules.
- 4. For the amount of Tuition Fees to be paid be different categories of students, please refer Pune University Circular No. Law/2002/365 dated 30-10-02.
- 5. Not with standing anything provided otherwise, the Tuition fee and Library fee are prescribed for the students from the State of Maharashtra. The tuition fee for the students who are from outside the State of Maharashtra will have to pay double the Tuition Fee and Non-residentIndian student, person of Indian origin, Foreign Citizens/Foreign Nationals will have to pay five times the Tuition Fees that is prescribed for the State of Maharashtra. The students from Bhutan, Nepal and Shrilanka will pay three times the Tuition fee as prescribed.
- 6. For the definition of 'Candidates in outside Maharashtra' please refer Savitribai Phule Pune University order dated 30-10-2002, relevant extract from which is given below: (Savitribai Phule Pune University order dated 30-10-2002)
- 7. Students with less attendance in the classes, non-participation in curricular and academic activities and non-appearance in the preliminary examinations will be liable to pay fine as per rules and regulations framed by college authorities.



### **Candidates outside Maharashtra**

Relevant extract from Order Dated 30-10-2002 of Savitribai Phule Pune University is this behalf is as follows:

- Maharashtra State Candidates: means a candidate passing S.S.C. or H.S.C. (std. XII) or both examination from recognized Institution in Maharashtra State.
- 2. Maharashtra Domiciled candidates: means a candidate passing H.S.C. (std. XII) examination from recognized Institution outside Maharashtra State but Father/Mother of the candidate or the candidate is domiciled of the state of Maharashtra, subject to production certificate from Competent Authority.
- Candidate from Outside Maharashtra State: means a candidate whose Domicile Status is outside Maharashtra and has passed his qualifying examination from University outsideMaharashtra. He will be eligible for admission as candidate from outside Maharashtra.

A candidate whose Domicile Status is outside Maharashtra state, but who has passed his qualifying examination from a Statutory University in the State of Maharashtra, but has passed his H.S.C. or its equivalent examination from a recognized school outside the State of Maharashtra will be eligible for admission to an institution which lies in the jurisdiction of the University. He will be considered as candidate from outside Maharashtra State.

A candidate whose Domicile Status is outside Maharashtra and who has passed his/her qualifying examination from Pune University but has passed his/her H.S.C. or equivalent examination from outside Maharashtra State, while filling in the application form for admission he/ she should indicate their Domicile Status as 'other than Maharashtra'.

### Refund of Fees on cancellation of admission as per University Rule:

The candidate canceling his/her admission will be entitled to receive the refund of fees after reducing the amounts as indicated in the following table

Sr.No.	Time of Cancellation	Deduction
1	From 1st day to 10 days from the date of securing admission	20% of the total fees
2	From 11th day to 30 days from the date of securing admission	40% of the total fees
3	After 30 days	100% of the total fees

### **Expectation from Students**

- Every Student seeking admission to the Adv. Shardulrao Sudhakarrao Jadhavar College Of Law is expected to adhere to the tradition of Jadhavar Foundation, Pune and the students should endeavor for excellence along with ethical and moral values.
- 2. Every student is required to approach for admission only if he aspires to excel in Legal Education. Students seeking admission other than for education are advised otherwise.
- 3. Every student while seeking admission shall subject himself to the disciplinary jurisdiction of the Vice-Chancellor, Authorities of Savitribai Phule Pune University, Authorities of Jadhavar Foundation, Authorities of Adv. Shardulrao Sudhakarrao Jadhavar College Of Law and shall abide by and strictly adhere to the rules made in that behalf by the mentioned authorities.
- 4. Every student is to maintain the decorum and educational environment within college premises. Loitering, damaging College property and facilities, insubordination shall incur strict disciplinary action by the College authorities.
- 5. Every student is required to attend classes regularly, attend court and lawyers' chambers as may be prescribed by the College authorities in reference and compliance to the S.P.P. U. and curriculum requirements. The College authorities, also have an extensive schedule for incumbent students to attend court, court proceeding and lawyers' chambers. All students are required to comply with the schedule. The same is part of the College endeavor to infuse practical approach at the very nascent stage of legal education.
- 6. Every student shall subject himself to strict discipline befitting an ideal student. No student shall indulge in any political activity in the College premises and during class timings. No associations, organization or societies shall be formed, established or invited in the College premises without prior permission of the College authorities.
- 7. Every student is required to acquaint himself/herself with the Maharashtra Universities Act 1994 (Ordinance No. 157) The same is regarding maintenance of discipline and good conduct by the students.
- 8. Every student is required to take part in various academic activities proposed and / or held by the College authorities. Seminars, Guest Lectures, Debates and Free Legal Aid Activities that are organized to develop the skills of students. The students are required to exploit the facilities provided by the College.

### **Instruction to Students**

- 1. Admission form must be completed by the student in his/her own and in clear handwriting. Admission procedure must be completed by the student in person.
- 2. The form should be filed in CAPITAL Letters Only.
- 3. Students may appraise themselves of all the rules and the procedure of admission as stated in the prospectus, any changes made thereafter, which will be displayed on the notice-board of the College. The time-table and procedure for admission can also be seen on the notice board. Timetable is subject to change, Students are excepted to see the notice boardregularly.
- 4. Students must submit along with the admission form:
- 5. Two additional photographs for identity card purposes with name behind the photograph(Stamp Size)
- 6. Attested true copies of the following documents, and must produce the originals at the timeof interviews/admission.
- 7. Statement of marks of the qualifying exam (XIIth for five year B.A. LL.B. Course, andgraduation from any faculty for three year LLB course, and Certificate Course. (Where grade system is followed in assessment, student shall also give transcripts of marks or any other documents indicating marks in the qualifying examination)
- 8. PassingCertificate
- 9. For date of birth purposes- Certificate copy of entry in birth register, or school leavingcertificate, or certificate of S.S.C. or equivalent examination.
- 10. a) Statement of marks of S.S.C. (Xth) or equivalent examination
  - b) Statement of marks of H.S.C.(XIIth) or equivalent examination
  - c) A student who has completed neither S.S.C. nor H.S.C.(or equivalent exams) from a recognized institution in Maharashtra, but who himself/herself or whose father or mother is domiciled in the state of Maharashtra must produce a domicile certificate of Competent Authority that he/she/father/mother is domiciled in the state of Maharashtra, else such student will be treated as a 'Candidate from Outside Maharashtra' for the purposes of admission and fees.
- 11. A student coming from a College affiliated to the Pune University or Maharashtra Higher Secondary Board must produce a transfer Certificate and School Leaving Certificate from that College/Board and School. A student coming from any other University or Board must produce a Migration Certificate, a Transfer Certificate and School Leaving Certificate from the University/College/Board/School. Else the student must undertake to produce and must produce the same within fifteen days from the date of admission.
- 12. Caste Certificate issued by appropriate authority b) In the case of such subcategories among. NT,VJNT,OBC to whom the creamy-layer criteria is applicable, a valid and subsisting certificate from the appropriate authority that the student does not belong to the Creamy Layer. IF SUCH CERTIFICATES ARE NOT SUBMITTED WITH THE ADMISSION FORM,THE STUDENT WILL BE CONSIDERED FOR ADMISSION IN THE OPEN CATEGORY FOR ALL PURPOSES.

- 13. If the student is employed, employers' permission to pursue the course and attend all the classes of the course.
- 14. DRESSCODE i.e. Black Trousers/Pants, White Shirt with tie, and Black shoes, White Dress for female students is compulsory for all students on everyday except Saturday.
- 15. Attendance to lectures/college is 75%, attendance on Saturday is strictly compulsory. No excuse shall be entertained if prior permission in writing is not obtained.
- 16. Submission of assignments is compulsory for academic development. Participation in college activities shall be observed and enforced.

# BAN on Smoking, the Sale and Consumption of Tobacco & Alcoholic Drinks in College premises:

Smoking, the Sell and Consumption of Tobacco & Alcoholic Drinks within the College premises and 100 meters radius beyond the college premises is strictly prohibited. Any person indulging in such activity is subject to suitable disciplinary action as per the existing laws.

### **Ban on Ragging:**

Strict action as per the law will be taken against students indulged in ragging in the College premises. Every student is required to submit online affidavit in this regard.

### **Academic**

To pass all Examination the student must obtain 40% of marks in each paper and 40% of the total marks obtainable in the examination. The rules of the ATKT (Allowed To Keep Term) are the same as prescribed by the Savitribai Phule Pune University The Semester System has been introduced for 5 years B.A.LL.B. course.

### **Attendance Rules**

- 1. Every student is required to maintain 75% (average) attendance per subject per month.
- 2. Attendance is to be maintained meticulously.
- 3. Optional Subject should be pre-decided within 10 days of admission or starting of lectures, whichever is earlier. (Attendance should be made accordingly)
- 4. Students who take leave for more than three consecutive days, are required to write a letter with reason which is to be submitted to the Class-Teacher beforehand to consider and examine their reason for absence. Letters submitted later will not be accepted and the student will be marked absent for those many days.
- 5. It is totally the Class Teacher/Principal's discretion whether to grant the student leave based on the application or not.
- 6. Medical-emergencies need to be supported with medical certificates.


